Taking part in the process.

The process for public participation in the consideration of a proposed plan modification under the Resource Management Act 1991 is as follows.

- After the closing date for submissions, the council must prepare a summary of decisions requested by submitters and give public notice of the availability of this summary and where the summary and submissions can be inspected; and
- there must be an opportunity to make further submissions in support of, or in opposition to, the submissions already made and
- if a person making a submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission, a hearing must be held; and
- the council must give its decision on the provisions and matters raised in the submissions (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions) and give public notice of its decision within two years of notifying the proposal and serve it on every person who made a submission at the same time; and
- any person who has made a submission has the right to appeal the decision on the proposed plan modification to the Environment Court if-
 - in relation to a provision or matter that is the subject of the appeal, the person referred to the provision or matter in the person's submission on the proposal; and
 - in the case of a proposal that is a proposed policy statement or plan, the appeal does not seek the withdrawal of the proposal as a whole.
