1. This form should be used in respect of on-Licences, off-Licences and club Licences. Special Licences are not renewable.
2. This application should be filed with the District Licensing Agency no later than 20 working days before the expiry of the Licence. After that time, it may be filed only with the permission of the District licensing Agency. In no case may the application be filed after the Licence has expired.
3. For the matters that are to accompany this application, see regulation 18(2) of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1990.
4. Within 20 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Agency, the applicant must give public notice of the application in form 1. The notice must be published twice in a newspaper or newspapers circulating in the district and nominated by the Secretary of the District Licensing Agency, with not less than 5 days and not more than 10 days between the 2 dates of publication.
5. Within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Agency, the applicant must ensure that notice of the application in form 1A is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which the application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Agency agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
6. Every application should be accompanied by the following:
 - a) Three copies of the application
 - b) The prescribed fee being \$776.00

Applicants are reminded that:

The complete application must be lodged with the Papakura District Licensing Agency **BEFORE** being publicly notified.

The application must be publicly notified on two separate occasions (not less than 5 and not more than 10 days apart) in The Papakura Courier.

The application **MUST ALSO** be publicly notified by displaying the public notice prominently at the entrance to the premises to be Licensed.

For your information, a scheme may be required where there is inadequate or no sprinkler system in a building and where there are 100 or more persons able to be assembled and more than 10 persons employed and more than 5 persons able to be accommodated.

Such an evacuation scheme shall provide for the evacuation from the scene of a fire to a place of safety outside the building.

Where a building is altered or there is a change of use, a review of any existing scheme may be required.

Please note: The owner of every building shall have an Evacuation **procedure** in place, where no Evacuation **scheme** is required.
