Wetback Installation:

If it is intended to connect the appliance to the hot water system it will be necessary to show on the above plan the position of the hot water cylinder and the position of pipes between the cylinder and the wetback.

IMPORTANT!

On completion of installation you will need a Code Compliance Certificate from Papakura District Council. There are two ways to obtain this:

- **submitting the "Producer Statement Construction" signed by the certified installer**
- **requesting a final inspection as per the inspection sheet attached to the approved plans.**
